Countdown to Move

Since October of 2020, Lexington House of Elkhart has been located at the River of Life Church. This location has been a great place for our Clubhouse to be located and grow. That said, we are outgrowing our location, and Standard 13 discusses many components that we need to look at such as having our own physical space and be adequate in size.

Since we opened, we have had 192 members join this Clubhouse. We have been averaging recent around 20 members that come and use the club each work order day. This is why we are outgrowing our space and are seeking a new space to

accommodate not only our current growth, but future growth. We have begun a countdown to when we are moving which we are using a chain link featured in the photo to get ready for this move.

The Clubhouse is located in its own physical space. It is separate from any mental health center or institutional settings, and is impermeable to other programs. The Clubhouse is designed to facilitate the work-ordered day and at the same time be attractive, adequate in size, and convey a sense of respect and dignity.

Lexington House currently shares some space with the River of Life church. Also, we do not share a mental health space with a community or state mental health facility, but we do refer people to those places. Currently, we are open eight hours a day, which reflects many businesses in their eight hour work day. At our current location, we are struggling for space as we are close to 20 colleagues a day, which is one of the reasons we are currently seeking a new space to accommodate our current colleagues that come, as well as future growth.

Recipe Corner: Tater Tot Casserole

Ingredients

- 1 lb. lean Ground Beef
- ¹/₂ onion, chopped
- 2 cloves Garlic, minced
- 1 can of Cream of Mushroom Soup
- 1/3 cup Sour Cream
- 1 cup of Corn
- 2 cups of shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1 Tbsp of Worcestershire Sauce
- 1 tsp salt, more to taste
- ¹/₄ tsp black pepper, more to taste
- 2 cups frozen Tater Tots
- Sliced scallions, for serving/ topping

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375. Spray a 9x9 inch baking dish with nonstick spray.
- 2. In a skillet, brown the beef over medium-high heat for a couple minutes, until about halfway cooked. Drain excess fat. Stir in the onions & garlic. Sauté until beef is cooked & onions are translucent.
- 3. Stir in cream of mushroom soup, sour cream, corn, 1/2 cup cheese, Worcestershire sauce, salt, and pepper. Cook on medium-low heat for a few minutes. Season to taste.
- 4. Spread beef mixture in the baking dish. Sprinkle with the remaining cheese and line the tater tots evenly over the top.
- 5. Bake for 30- 35 minutes or until tots are golden brown & cheese is bubbling. Top with sliced scallions.

Makes about 6 servings.
