Kitchen Corner: Chicken Tortilla Soup

Ingredients

- 1 pound boneless skinless chicken breasts
- 1 Tablespoon olive oil, more as needed
- 1 onion, chopped/ diced
- 3 cloves minced garlic
- 29 oz chicken broth
- 1.5 cups corn (frozen or canned, 1 can)
- 1 Tablespoon of chili powder
- 1 can of Black beans (rinsed)
- 1.5 Tablespoons fresh lemon or lime juice
- 1.5 cups chunky salsa
- Salt & Pepper
- Tortilla chips/ strips
- Optional: Sour Cream,
 Shredded cheese, green onions, cilantro, avocado

Instructions

- 1. In a large pot, heat the oil over medium heat. Add the chicken in. Sprinkle salt & pepper over top. Sautee until chicken is about halfway cooked.
- 2. Add the onions & a clove of minced Garlic. Sautee until chicken is finished cooking. This is the base of your soup.
- 3. Next add the chicken broth, chili powder, beans (rinsed), corn, lemon juice & salsa. Reduce heat to low, cover and simmer for 20–30 minutes.
- 4. Top the soup with fresh cilantro if desired. Break up some tortilla chips or strips and add to individual bowls. Ladle soup over tortillas. Add desired toppings.

Makes about 6 servings.
