Standard 8 states:

"All Clubhouse meetings are open to both members and staff. There are no formal member only meetings or formal staff only meetings where program decisions and member issues are discussed."

At Lexington House we have meetings every day, and any colleague or staff is allowed to meet. We do not have any meeting where we say "so-and-so" cannot attend. A big meeting we have each week is on Wednesday where any member or staff can bring up an issue or concern. This meeting is our program meeting. After the issue is brought up, the colleagues and staff discuss the issue and we try to come to a consensus on what to do about the issue.
